## Tips for Internship Sites: Accepting Electronic Applications



## Select a platform to receive applications

Platform options include but are not limited to:

- Using an existing email address
- Creating a new email address specifically for internship applications
- Using a third-party platform like Dropbox, Google Drive, OneDrive



## Connect with your IT department

Connect with your IT department to ensure that documents sent from external email domains will not be blocked.



## **Develop Submission Instructions**

It is important to include submission instructions on your website for applicants. Example submission instructions:

- 1) Complete the Internship Readiness Common Application found at <a href="https://aclp.smapply.io/">https://aclp.smapply.io/</a>. Detailed instructions on how to complete the application can be found in the guide <a href="https://example.com/here/">here/</a>.
- 2) Email the downloaded application to INSERT EMAIL ADDRESS
- 3) The email subject line should state the internship session (winter/spring, fall, summer) and year.
- 4) The PDF downloaded as part of the ACLP Internship Readiness Common Application is the only component that will be reviewed. No additional documentation will be required or reviewed for a candidate's initial submission (no letters of recommendation, cover letters, resumes, etc.).
